

Maintenance of the WPC board

Caring for the terrace of the WPC will not require special financial costs and special means. It is enough to wash the surface once a week with warm soapy water or water it with water from a hose under pressure. What to do in case of various problems:

1. Spilled oils and sauces from the terrace board should be removed immediately with a damp cloth. If some time has passed - with a soapy solution.
2. If the initial treatment does not help, use a soft brush, as well as non-abrasive detergents and soaps.
3. To remove greasy wine or coffee stains, you can use special stain removers.
4. After using any chemicals, you need to rinse the flooring with water.
5. There should be no debris left in the gaps so as not to impede air circulation.
6. When placing furniture or flower stands on the terrace, put silicone pads on the legs.
7. Textile or vinyl mats should be laid on the floor, as rubber mats can stain it.
8. Do not put hot dishes on the terrace board.

Even with careful regular maintenance, dark spots may appear on the board:

- from rain and dew: precipitation can leave darkening;
- large amounts of dust can also leave dark spots. If repair or other dust-generating work will be carried out next to the terrace, it is better to cover the board.

To remove them, special stain removers without bleaching components are used.

It is recommended to use: environmentally friendly cleaners that do not contain harmful chemicals (bleaches, ammonia, organic compounds). They effectively remove mold, grease stains and other contaminants.

It is not recommended to use hard water, because it contains dissolved salts of alkaline earth metals (so-called "hardness salts" - calcium, magnesium). This can lead to the appearance of a white coating on the terrace board. In such cases, water softening units and filters are used.
